## FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER VACANCY

The Hampden Police Department, being a non-civil service agency, currently is looking to hire a **POST Certified Police Officer** for an immediate fulltime vacancy. Applications can be obtained at **[www.hampdenpolice.com](http://www.hampdenpolice.com)**. Please submit an application, cover letter and resumes for the position of full-time police officer.

The Hampden Police Department is a full-service police agency. Duties in this position are under direct supervision and a high quality of service is expected. Patrol officers' purpose is to enforce state laws related to prevention of crime, the apprehension of offenders, the protection of property and persons, the preservation of public peace and the control of traffic; performs investigative duties and related to public service work assigned.

Minimum requirements: Must be at least 21 years of age, must have a valid license, preferred to be a graduate of the basic full time Massachusetts Police Training Academy or equivalent and be **Massachusetts Post Certified** as a police officer, have a college degree and/ or prior military service is preferred.

Candidates must be able to possess a Class A License to carry a firearm, ability to work any hours and in all weather conditions, ability to learn and demonstrate job requirements after being trained. Applicants must be able to pass a Physical Ability Test and successfully complete an interview process. A medical exam, a psychological exam, as well as an extensive background investigation will be conducted on finalists.

In addition to the base salary there is an educational incentive for eligible degrees.

In accordance with state law, no applicant who has ever been convicted of a felony can be appointed as a Police Officer. Applicants are kept on file for one year after the date of receipt. Town of Hampden is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
