About the NTER Master Trainer Program

The **Master Trainer Program (MTP)** certifies Federal, State, Local, Tribal, and Territorial (F/SLTT) partners to teach Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management (BTAM) best practices and techniques. Through the **Master Trainer Certification Roadmap**, including the **Instructor Development Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course (ID-TERC)**, participants gain the skills to train their communities, help mitigate threats, and support terrorism and targeted violence prevention efforts.

Eligibility

- F/SLTT partners working in public safety, emergency response, or violence prevention--including public agencies, schools, hospitals, and other government-operated organizations.
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- This program is **NOT** currently available to private sector employees.

Cost

- **Tuition: FREE**
- **Participants or their agencies are responsible for all travel expenses to attend the ID-TERC.**

- **Preferred:** Supervisory employee of F/ SLTT agency w/ professional or academic experience in targeted violence prevention or BTAM
- Certified instructor/trainer

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
